Spanish Springs Vineyard is one of the closest vineyards to the Pacific Ocean in California. It sits just 2 miles inland from Pismo Beach. This site produces wines with great structure and ample amounts of acidity. We work with two different clones to create our vineyard designate Syrah. This vineyard is SIP certified (Sustainable in Practice).

Harvest Date: Hand harvested early morning of November 8th, 2018

Brix: 23.5-25.5 at harvest

Varietal: 100% Syrah

Blend: 51% #383 & 49% #877

35% whole cluster, native fermentation in 1.5 ton fermentors 6 day cold soak

21 day ferment then pressed into barrel.

Barrel Age: Aged 15 months in French oak barrels. 16% new French oak barrels, 90%

seasoned French oak barrels.

Bottled: April 23rd, 2020

Alcohol: 14.8%
