The Rincon Vineyard is the home vineyard where Don Talley planted the first vines of Talley Vineyards in 1982 and where the winery is located. Consisting of two hillsides rising from the floor of the Arroyo Grande Valley, the clay calcareous soils of the West Rincon Vineyard yield wines with distinctive minerality and iron notes.

Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir

15% whole cluster native fermentation in 1.5 ton fermentor.

4-5 day cold soak

14 day ferment, then pressed into barrel.

Barrel Age: Aged 11 months in French oak barrels. 28% new oak, 14% 1 year old barrel, 58% seasoned French oak barrels.
Bottled: August 8th, 2017
Alcohol: 13.8%
Production: 7 barrels -157 cases
